- 15. To initiate for taking measures for the benefit of people towards environmental consciousness, hygiene and health.
- 16. To construct, maintain, improve, develop and build college and school building and other houses and offices for carrying out the various activities of the Trust from time to time.

- 29) The power of trustees shall have full powers and authority to administer the trust, the Institutions, properties and fund and to do such acts, deeds and things as are calculated to promote the objects for which this Trust is created. They shall be entitled to act, notwithstanding any vacancy in the Board of trustees.

- 31) The Settlers may appoint Consultants, Committees, advisory

The Income Tax Act, 1961. Further no amendment shall be carried out without the prior approval of the Commissioner of Income Tax. The amendments shall be such that it shall not take away of the charitable nature of the Trust and shall also be such that the

exemptions under Section 11 of the Income Tax Act, 1961 would be available to it.

- 34) The settlers can include or exclude new trustees with proper resolution.
- 35) After every five years by mutual consent and new resolution of the settlers of the trust "Heritage Education and "Welfare Trust".
